Find out all the key information on FIFA's new global club tournament with details of participating teams, dates, competition format, hosts and more.

FIFA's new prime club competition - the FIFA Club World Cup™ - will grace the world stage in June and July 2025, when 32 of the globe's leading teams gather in the USA for the inaugural edition.

This truly global event will bring together the most successful club sides from each of the six international confederations: AFC, CAF, Concacaf, CONMEBOL, OFC and UEFA.

Here, FIFA brings you everything you need to know on the tournament.

Who is hosting the FIFA Club World Cup 2025?

The first edition of FIFA's new prime club competition will be played in the USA.

When will the FIFA Club World Cup 2025 be played?

The tournament will take place from 15 June to 13 July 2025.

Which stadiums will host the FIFA Club World Cup 2025?

A total of 12 venues will be used to host the 63 matches which will be played across the United States, with the final to be played at MetLife Stadium in New York New Jersey.

What is the FIFA Club World Cup 2025 format?

A group stage composed of eight groups of four teams per group playing in a single-game round-robin format.

The top two teams per group progress to the round of 16.

A direct single-match knockout stage from the round of 16 to the final.

No third-place play-off.

The first-ever 32-team FIFA Club World Cup will take place in the USA in 2025, with 12 venues across the nation chosen to host matches.

Mercedes-Benz Stadium

Location: Atlanta, GA

Opened: 2017



Home to Atlanta United of Major League Soccer (MLS) and the National Football League's (NFL) Atlanta Falcons, the Mercedes-Benz Stadium boasts a retractable roof and 360-degree halo video display. Eight FIFA World Cup 26 fixtures will take place in Atlanta, including the semi-final and two other knockout ties. The MLS All-Star Game, College Football Play-off National Championship Game, Super Bowl LIII, numerous international friendlies, and concerts from global superstars have all taken place at this spectacular arena.

Bank of America Stadium

Location: Charlotte, NC.

Opened: 1996

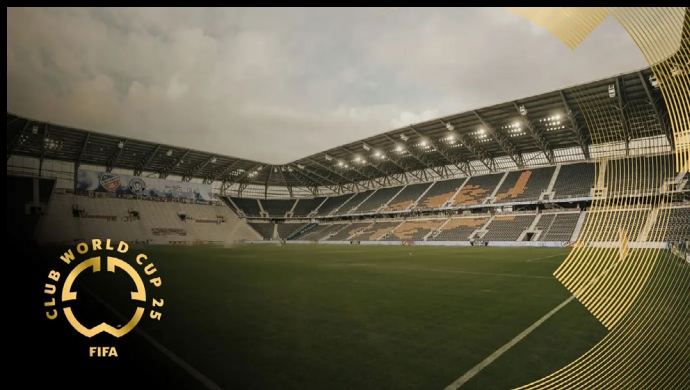


MLS expansion franchise Charlotte FC have used Bank of America Stadium as their home ground since their opening season in 2022. The venue is well versed in hosting soccer fixtures, with a number of international and club friendlies having been held here, in addition to Concacaf Gold Cup dates and two knockout games in the 2024 Copa America. NFL outfit Carolina Panthers have called the Charlotte venue home since 1996 and it has been used for several play-off matches.

TQL Stadium

Location: Cincinnati, OH

Opened: 2021



The award-winning TQL Stadium may only have been completed in 2021, but it has already played host to a number of memorable club and international fixtures. The USMNT's first visit to the venue came in November 2021, when they recorded an impressive 2-0 victory over Mexico in FIFA World Cup qualifying for Qatar 2022. MLS side FC Cincinnati play their home fixtures here, while the USWNT have enjoyed two goal-laden outings with victories over Paraguay (8-0) and South Africa (3-0) in 2021 and 2023 respectively.

Rose Bowl Stadium

Location: Los Angeles, CA

Opened: 1922



There are few more iconic stadia across the world than Pasadena's Rose Bowl, which celebrated its centenary in 2022. The sweeping seating throughout the circular arena provides an uninterrupted view to the playing field for all spectators, and was the venue for the FIFA World Cup Final™ in 1994, when Brazil were crowned champions for the fourth time in their history following a dramatic penalty shootout victory over Italy. The FIFA Women's World Cup Final™ of 1999 also took place here, when the host nation prevailed on penalties against China PR.

Hard Rock Stadium

Location: Miami, FL

Opened: 1987



The stadium hosts a multitude of events and is home to NFL's Miami Dolphins, Formula 1 Miami Grand Prix, the Miami Open tennis tournament, University of Miami, Orange Blossom Classic and Orange Bowl college football games, Jazz in the Gardens and other festivals. Six Super Bowls, multiple major concerts and international soccer matches have taken place here, and it is another venue on the roster for FIFA World Cup 26. The venue will have the honour of hosting the opening match at the Club World Cup, in the same state where host nation club Inter Miami are based.

GEODIS Park

Location: Nashville, TN

Opened: 2022



The most recently constructed stadium on the roster for the FIFA Club World Cup, GEODIS Park is the largest soccer-specific stadium in the US and Canada, with fans throughout the ground brought close to the action, with the furthest distance from seat to touchline standing at 150 feet. The home venue for MLS side Nashville SC, the newly built arena has already welcomed both the USMNT and the USWNT and has hosted several major concerts, including Shania Twain, P!nk and Green Day.

MetLife Stadium

Location: East Rutherford, NYNJ

Opened: 2010

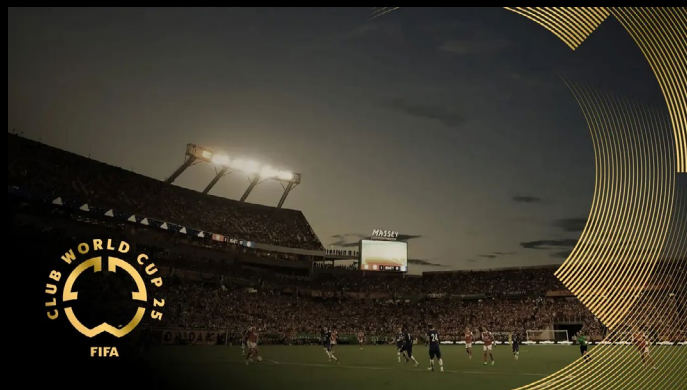


This multipurpose stadium currently hosts the NFL's New York Giants and New York Jets and was the venue for the final of the 2016 Copa America Centenario, when Chile defeated Lionel Messi's Argentina on penalties. Numerous A-list performers have featured here, including Bruce Springsteen and The E Street Band, Beyonce, Ed Sheeran and Taylor Swift. The venue has been chosen to host the FIFA World Cup 26 Final, on top of two further knockout ties and five group-stage matches.

Camping World Stadium

Location: Orlando, FL

Opened: 1936



Originally opened almost 90 years ago, Camping World Stadium has undergone multiple expansions and re-fits in the intervening years, culminating in the 2014 redevelopment which saw the creation of a 90 per cent all-new stadium following an investment of over \$200 million. A host of sporting, entertainment and musical events have taken place at the Orlando venue, with The Rolling Stones, Paul McCartney, Billy Joel and Elton John all taking to the stage, while WrestleMania XXIV wowed a venue-record crowd of 74,635 in 2008.

Inter&Co Stadium

Location: Orlando, FL

Opened: 2017



This soccer-specific venue is the home ground of MLS outfit Orlando City and National Women's Soccer League (NWSL) side Orlando Pride. Both the USMNT and USWNT have graced the field at Inter&Co Stadium, with the men's side featuring in FIFA World Cup qualifiers in 2018 and 2022, and the women's team appearing during the SheBelieves Cup in 2018, 2020 and 2023. Away from soccer, the 2022 Special Olympics USA Games Opening Ceremony took place here.

Lincoln Financial Field

Location: Philadelphia, PA

Opened: 2003



It is perhaps fitting that the first ticketed event at Lincoln Financial Field was the eye-catching friendly between European rivals Barcelona and Manchester United in August 2003, with Patrick Kluivert having the honour of scoring the venue's first goal. Now home to NFL side Philadelphia Eagles, the impressive arena has also been selected to host five group-stage matches and a Round of 16 tie during the eagerly anticipated 48-team FIFA World Cup 26™.

Lumen Field

Location: Seattle, WA

Opened: 2002



The city of Seattle has two reasons to celebrate the FIFA Club World Cup 2025, with Seattle Sounders FC having qualified as Concacaf Champions League winners in 2022 and the iconic Lumen Field - which boasts a unique horseshoe shape with an open north end that gives a stunning view of the city skyline - named as a host venue. Sounders will play all three group-stage games at the FIFA Club World Cup 2025™ at Lumen Field and their home stadium will host six matches in total. The beautiful game will return in 2026, with the stadium selected for FIFA World Cup 26, with four group-stage matches - which include USA's second Group D meeting, a Round of 32 tie and a Round of 16 contest.

Audi Field

Location: Washington, D.C.

Opened: 2018



D.C. United, one of the most successful teams in MLS history, calls Audi Field home, alongside NWSL side, the Washington Spirit. Since opening in 2018, the venue has hosted a variety of sports, concerts, and events at the soccer-specific stadium. The USWNT most recently played their final warm-up match before the Paris Olympics at Audi Field, drawing 0-0 with Costa Rica before going on to claim gold under new coach Emma Hayes. The USMNT had mixed fortunes from their first two visits to Audi Field in 2019, losing the first 1-0 to Jamaica in an international friendly before a resounding 7-0 success over Cuba in Concacaf Nations League action. In addition, Audi Field also hosted the 2023 MLS All-Star match against Arsenal FC from the Premier League.

The new FIFA Club World Cup trophy, designed by FIFA and crafted in collaboration with global luxury jeweller Tiffany & Co., will be presented for the first time to the FIFA Club World Cup 2025™ winners, who will be crowned after the final at the MetLife Stadium in New York New Jersey on 13 July.

“Innovative, inclusive, groundbreaking and truly global, the new 32-team FIFA Club World Cup deserves a trophy that represents all of this. It is both prestigious and timeless – a golden trophy that is a symbol of the future and inspired by the past,” said FIFA President Gianni Infantino on the occasion of the trophy unveiling.

“The team who lift this trophy will hold the world of club football in their hands. To the players who win it, history belongs to you! Let’s take it to the world and celebrate it as we look forward to the start of a new era for football when the one and only FIFA club world champions lift the FIFA Club World Cup Trophy in New York New Jersey on 13 July 2025.”

The President and Chief Executive Officer of Tiffany & Co., Anthony Ledru, added: “With a legacy dating back 160 years, Tiffany & Co. has crafted some of the most iconic championship trophies in history, setting the standard for craft and design. The FIFA Club World Cup Trophy is the next chapter in our long history of creating the world’s most revered symbols of athletic achievement.”

A symbol of the future, inspired by the past

Boasting a 24-carat gold-plated finish, the FIFA Club World Cup Trophy features intricate laser-engraved inscriptions on both sides, showcasing text and imagery that portray football's rich history. The inscriptions include a world map and the names of all 211 FIFA Member Associations and the six confederations, representing the geographical and cultural diversity of the beautiful game.

The trophy's central disc displays an array of icons that capture football's traditions, including symbols of stadiums and equipment and a world map.

The trophy also features engravings in 13 languages and Braille, further highlighting the inclusive spirit of the global game and ensuring that the tournament's legacy is accessible to diverse audiences around the world. Space is available to laser-engrave the emblems of the winning clubs for 24 editions of the tournament. Furthermore, the trophy can transform from a shield into a multifaceted and orbital structure – an adaptable design that establishes a powerful visual structure.



The famous Voyager Golden Records carried on NASA's Voyager deep-space missions in the 1970s, the periodic table, maps of pioneering journeys and astronomy each played a role in the trophy's conceptualisation. Celebrating both the past and the future of the sport, the trophy features celestial symbols representing the approximate positions of planets at the time of FIFA's foundation on Saturday, 21 May 1904 in Paris, France, and of the tournament's opening match on 15 June 2025 in Miami, USA.

An inspiring message to the champions is engraved on the trophy, including the following: "To those who hold this trophy, history belongs to you! You are witness to a moment in time that represents the pinnacle of club football, bestowed upon few but celebrated by many." These words reflect the trophy's status as a symbol of greatness, honouring the legends of the past while inspiring clubs globally.

A trophy for champions

The champions at each edition will receive a replica of the FIFA Club World Cup Trophy featuring engravings that mark their triumph after the final. This official FIFA Club World Cup Winner's Trophy mirrors the perpetual trophy in its craft, construction and scale – complete with official nameplates emblazoned with club emblems, along with dates relating to their victory.

FIFA has announced adidas as the Official Supplier of the inaugural Club World Cup, with the long-standing FIFA partner unveiling the tournament's Official Match Ball.

The ball's design pays homage to the host nation, the United States, incorporating bold graphics and emblems that celebrate and reflect the country's heritage. Set against a pearlescent background, the match ball showcases striking jagged-edged block patterns and deconstructed stars and stripes in red, white and blue in a nod to the nation's flag.



The Official Match Ball is engineered to provide greater in-game accuracy thanks to PRECISIONSHELL – a 20-piece panel shape with strategically placed debossed grooves on the ball's outer shell. Another performance benefit is to be found under the surface in the form of CTR-CORE technology, which is designed to enhance accuracy and consistency in flight and helps to retain maximum shape and air retention with a view to supporting fast, precise play.

In addition, the integrated connected ball technology sends inertial measurement unit data to the video-assistant-referee system at a rate of 500 times per second in real time. When combined with player position data and the application of artificial intelligence, the technology helps video match officials to make faster offside decisions and can also aid them in identifying each individual touch of the ball, resulting in reduced delays in resolving specific incidents, e.g. possible handball offences.

As well as supplying the Official Match Ball, adidas is set to provide uniforms for match officials, volunteers and FIFA staff across the tournament, with the garments reflecting the sports manufacturer's commitment to quality and sustainability, offering high-performance apparel for those at the heart of the event.

FIFA Club World Cup 2025™

The draw for the inaugural FIFA Club World Cup 2025™ took place at the Telemundo Center in Miami, USA on 5 December 2024, producing a host of intriguing fixtures for the new global club tournament.

15-time European champions Real Madrid C.F. will play Saudi Arabia's Al Hilal, CF Pachuca of Mexico and FC Salzburg in Group H, while Brazil's SE Palmeiras go up against FC Porto, Egyptian giants Al Ahly FC and Inter Miami CF in Group A.

Manchester City were pitted against Morocco's Wydad AC, Al Ain FC of the United Arab Emirates and Juventus FC in Group G, while 2022 CONMEBOL Copa Libertadores winners CR Flamengo will meet Espérance de Tunisie, Chelsea FC and LAFC of the USA in Group D.

- Bayern were crowned champions of Germany for a record 34th time this season, finishing 13 points ahead of last season's winners Leverkusen. They have now claimed the title in 12 of the last 13 seasons.
- Bayern are without doubt one of their continent's most successful clubs having been crowned champions of Europe on six occasions, most recently in 2020. They secured their place at the FIFA Club World Cup 2025™ due to the club's strong performances in the UEFA Champions League over the four-year qualifying period (2021-2024), when they reached at least the quarter-final stage each season.
- On 1 September 2024 Thomas Müller played his 710th game for Bayern in all competitions, breaking the club appearance record previously held by legendary goalkeeper Sepp Maier.

- Born in Seattle, Brian Schmetzer has been either the head coach or assistant coach at the club since 2002.
- Peruvian striker Raúl Ruidíaz scored twice in their 3-0 second-leg home win of the 2022 Concacaf Champions Cup final against Mexican side UNAM, giving the MLS club the trophy 5-2 on aggregate.
- Uruguayan star Nicolas Lodeiro scored three goals in Seattle Sounders FC' 5-2 aggregate victory over Mexican side Pumas UNAM in the 2022 Concacaf Champions Cup final, thus earning their place at the FIFA Club World Cup 2025™. The triumph against Mexican side Pumas saw them become the first team from the USA to be crowned Concacaf champions in 22 years.
- In 2024, Seattle-born striker, Jordan Morris, a member of the USA squad at Qatar 2022, enjoyed his most prolific goalscoring season since joining the club in 2016 having scored a career-high tally of 13 goals in the 2024 MLS regular season.

Qualification mechanism

With the objective of ensuring the highest quality possible based on sporting criteria over the most recent four seasons, starting from the group stage of the confederation's relevant premier club competition, and incentivising the result of every game in the respective tournament, the following methodology for the new standard ranking was approved:

- 3 points for a win
- 1 point for a draw
- 3 points for progress to each stage of the competition

In the case of European clubs, given that three full seasons and a full group stage of the fourth season of the UEFA Champions League have already been completed, and since UEFA has an existing club coefficient system, the pre-existing methodology principles for the purpose of calculating the UEFA club coefficient in relation to matches in the UEFA Champions League only will be exceptionally applied to determine the ranking of European clubs for the FIFA Club World Cup 2025™.

The approved methodology for the ranking of European teams is therefore as follows:

- 2 points for a win
- 1 point for a draw
- 4 points for qualification for the group stage
- 5 points for qualification for the round of 16
- 1 point for progress to each stage of the competition thereafter

- Only if there are repeated champions of the confederation's relevant premier club competition, clubs with best Ranking within the Confederation

Confederations with < 4 slots

- Clubs with best Ranking within the Confederation among the champions of the confederation's relevant premier club competition

Additional criteria

- A cap of two clubs per country is applied to the access list with the exception in case more than two clubs from the same country win the confederation's premier club competition over the four-year period.
- In case of a tie, the criteria are: 1) Best individual result achieved during the qualifying period 2) Most recent best result 3) Best goal difference 4) Most goals scored
